

# Suggested Packing List for Schlitterbahn

## Camp Gear (to be put under the bus)

- To be left in camp:
- Toiletries
- Ground pad
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag
- Hammock (optional, may not be allowed depending on park rules)
- Cup
- Eating utensils – fork, spoon, and knife (do not assume that your patrol will provide these!)
- Personal first aid kit
- Bug spray
- Extra shorts, shirts, socks
- Camp shoes (no open-toed shoes permitted)
  
- To be worn / brought to Schlitterbahn:
- Swim trunks
- Towel
- Sun screen
- Water bottle
- Non-cook lunch (to be provided by patrol)
- Money (optional; bring if additional food, drinks, or souvenirs are desired)
- Sandals, water shoes, etc. (optional)

## Bus Bag (to be put on the bus)

- To be taken off the bus upon arrival:
- Full change of clothes (shorts, shirt, and socks. No part of Class A may be taken off the bus.)
- Rain gear
- Flashlight (headlamp is best)
  
- To be left on the bus in bus bag:
- Cell phones and other electronics
- Wallet, keys, etc.
- Full Class A
  
- Entertainment suggestions (no electronics may be taken off the bus):

- Music players (iPod, Zune, etc.)
- Portable gaming devices (Nintendo DS, PSP, etc.)
- VHS films (Maximum rating: PG-13)
- Books, other reading material

#### Miscellaneous (to be turned in before boarding the bus)

- Park entrance fee (\$28 for those 11 or younger, \$33 for those older than 11)
- Medications and medication list
- Money from bag sale (if any is still unpaid)
- Money for food (figure \$10 - \$15)
