Discipline Policy

In the Scouting program, everyone is expected to follow the principles of the Scout Oath and Law. When a Scout oversteps the boundaries of this code he can be disruptive to the others in the program. Serious or recurring negative activities, such as cheating, lying, inappropriate language, vandalism, fighting or disrespect of the others are examples of unacceptable behavior. If a scout continually disrupts activities, fails to correct disruptive or disrespectful behavior, or whose actions endangers himself or others, the parents of that scout will be contacted to come and collect the scout. Prior to further participation, the youth, parents and Scoutmaster will hold a conference to review proper behavior.
